**Scope & Content**

**Biography:** Bridget Bond is one of the most well-known leaders in the civil rights movement in Derry. Bond was a member of Derry Housing Action Committee and the Northern Ireland Civil Rights Association. Bridget Bond also played a major role in the creation of the Bloody Sunday Monument.

**Collection Scope and Content:** Collection of items relating to the civil rights movement of Derry, includes correspondence, posters, reports, flyers and minutes of meetings. The collection was donated to the Museum and Visitor Services.

Topics include several first-hand accounts from journalists and from those wounded, accounts of deaths on Bloody Sunday, explanation of march and its intent, and a map detailing what occurred that day. No date provided, published by Civil Rights Movement.

Envelope addressed to “Derry Civil Rights Association, Tremore Gds., Cregan [sic], Derry.” Letter addressed to the Derry Civil Rights Association in Belfast, signed Cecil King, dated 26<sup>th</sup> July 1972, beginning “Dear Sir, with reference to your article in the Evening Press regarding a Memorial to Bloody Sunday...”. Goes on to detail the author’s wish to be commissioned by the Association for the production of a commemorative sculpture for Bloody Sunday. He also provides examples of his other work. Two black and white photographs are also present, showing a two foot model of artist’s proposed sculpture.

#### **Mss.6.1.4 Reporter’s Note Books – undated**

Three reporter’s note books, no dates visible, different colours and sizes. Details include various names and addresses, thought to be of those suffering from poor housing conditions. Subjects include accounts of family situations resulting from poor housing, record of poor state of several houses, at least one record of violence, an account of unfair arrest by the army, and one missing person’s account.
